Indigenous Data Sovereignty

- Data Sovereignty is the right of a Nation to collect and manage its own data (data is subject to the laws of the nation within which it is stored)
- Indigenous Data Sovereignty is the right of the nation to govern the collection, ownership and application of its own data (data is subject to the laws of the nation from which it is collected, including Tribal nations)

...Is the right of Māori to access, to use, to have governance and control over Māori Data
